MAKE UP REMOVING PETALS!



RONDA GILGER CROCHET DESIGNS

While in London I realized I had forgotten my facial make up removal "soft-scrubbies".

Funny: I did not forget my crochet hook or knitting needles or ample yarn... (what does that tell you?)

So I set to work crocheting a bundle of little flower-power make-up removal pads which can be used, thrown in the wash and reused over and over. What an earth friendly idea!

This is a fun pattern and after making one or two you will crochet them with ease. For girlfriend gifts I crocheted 10 flowers of assorted colors from cotton yarns, and placed them inside of a 4x6" toile and ribbon sachet pouches available at most crafts stores for about \$1.

What a thoughtful, wonderful gift!

Care: Throw them in the washer with your laundry. They wash and dry up beautifully.

For this project you will need:

1. US Size D Crochet Hook. 3.0 mm.
2. Sport weight cotton yarn scraps– Using sport weight creates a smaller, tighter make up removal flower.

Tip: These can be made with one solid color yarn for your entire flower– or you can change colors on each row. Pictured are a variety of petals using the same pattern, but alternating colors of cotton yarns on rows 2,3 or 4.

DIRECTIONS:

- Row 1: ch 4, sl st into 1st chain to form loop.
- Row 2: ch 2 (forms 1st dc). 11 dc, sl st into 1st dc space.
- Row 3: ch 1, 2 sc in each dc of previous row (24 sc). Sl st into 1st sc space.
- Row 4: * 5 dc in 2nd space from sl st, sl st in 2nd space to complete petal (shell). Repeat from * 5 times (6 petals total). Tie off and weave in ends.

• Stitches you will use:

- ch: chain sl st: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet dc: double crochet
